What is CNA Prep Course?

How long is the course?

Is the state exam included in tuition?

How soon do I need to schedule my exam after the course?



- According to AHCA policies you have 30 days after you have completed and passed with proof of certification to register to take your prometric CNA state exam.

How is this CNA Prep Course different from the CNA Course?
